## KnowBe4 Login Instructions

- Navigate to <https://training.knowbe4.com>
- Enter your Rutgers email in the format 'netID@rutgers.edu'
- Enter your **SSO credentials** (your Rutgers netID + password)
- Approve the **DUO push** sent to your personal device
- Click on the '**Training**' tab at the top left of the screen to view the modules assigned to you
- Click '**Start**' next to any module to begin your training

## Enrolling in Training

KnowBe4 licenses are available for all Rutgers staff and faculty, and all guests/student workers who have access to data requiring training under a specific mandate (CMMC, PCI-DSS, GLBA, etc.). Directors, managers or supervisors must **submit a request** to the Compliance and Training Team to enroll their personnel in mandatory compliance training. Staff and faculty are also welcome to take voluntary/supplemental training at any time by visiting the '**Library**' tab on the KnowBe4 dashboard, no enrollment required!

## Troubleshooting Tips



### Exiting a Module

Make sure you do not exit a module using the browser window's 'X' button (unless the module specifically tells you to do so). If you exit a module prematurely or incorrectly, it will not mark itself 'Complete.'



### Timed Modules

Some modules, including policy attestations, require a minimum amount of time spent within the module before it can be marked 'Complete.'



### A Module Won't Load or Progress

Most modules work in **Chrome, Firefox, MS Edge, and Safari**. However, if a module fails to load, buttons appear to be missing, or the module will not mark as 'Complete,' try the following steps:

- Clear your browser cache and refresh
- Try a different browser
- Try using the mobile app instead of a desktop, or vice versa
