1 Question unusual, unexpected, or urgent requests

Cyber attackers impersonate people you trust. Don't fall for it.

2 Think before you click

Not sure if a link is legit? Then don't click.

3 Verify email addresses

If an email seems suspicious, verify the request with a phone call or text.

4 Know how to report suspicious activity
