

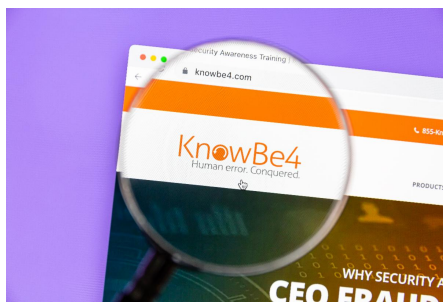

Cyber safe in less than 30 minutes

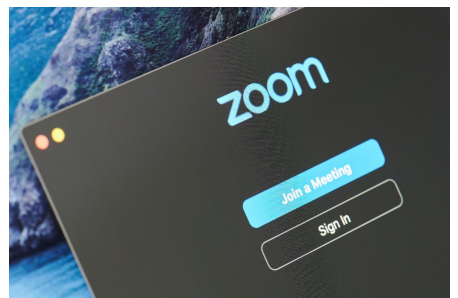
